BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 Article - Land Use 25-101.4 This title applies only in Prince George's County. 5 **25-214.** 6 (A) 7 **(1)** IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 8 INDICATED. "CONCRETE BATCHING PLANT" MEANS A FACILITY USED TO 9 **(2)** (I)10 PRODUCE CONCRETE BY MIXING AGGREGATE WITH CEMENT. "CONCRETE BATCHING PLANT" INCLUDES STRUCTURES 11 (II)12 USED TO STOCKPILE BULK MATERIALS REQUIRED FOR THE PROCESS OR TO STORE EQUIPMENT REQUIRED FOR USE IN THE PRODUCTION OF CONCRETE. 13 14 **(3)** "SETBACK DISTANCE" MEANS THE DISTANCE MEASURED FROM 15 THE CONCRETE BATCHING PLANT, INCLUDING ANY LOCATION ON THE PROPERTY 16 THAT IS USED FOR THE PRODUCTION OF CONCRETE, TO ANY RESIDENTIAL BUILDING 17 IN ALL DIRECTIONS.
- 18 (B) EACH CONCRETE BATCHING PLANT APPROVED FOR CONSTRUCTION ON
- 19 OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2021, SHALL COMPLY WITH A MINIMUM SETBACK DISTANCE
- 20EQUAL TO NOT LESS THAN 1,000 FEET.
- 21SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22October 1, 2021.
