AMENDMENT TO PG 407-21 (HOUSE BILL 635)
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert "EMERGENCY BILL"; and in line 15, after "Assembly;" insert "requiring the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the governing body of each municipal corporation in Prince George's County, or the municipal corporation's designee, be invited to participate in the study; encouraging the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the governing body of each municipal corporation in the county, or the municipal corporation's designee, to participate in the study; making this Act an emergency measure;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 18, after "(a)" insert "(1)"; and after line 20, insert:

"(2) The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the governing body of each municipal corporation in Prince George's County, or the municipal corporation's designee, shall be invited and, is encouraged, to participate in the study."

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 15 and 16, and substitute:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted."

EXPLANATION OF AMENDMENT NO. 2

The amendment makes the bill an emergency measure and requires the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and each municipality in the county, or the municipality's designee, to be invited to participate in the study. The Corps of Engineers and the municipalities are also encouraged to participate.
