A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George’s County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class B–Stadium (Baseball**
3 **Stadium) Beer, Wine, and Liquor License**

4 **PG 306–23**

5 FOR the purpose of altering the alcoholic beverages that may be sold under a certain
6 stadium license in Prince George’s County; authorizing the holder of a Class
7 B–Stadium (baseball stadium) beer, wine, and liquor license to sell beer, wine, and
8 liquor for on–premises consumption; altering a provision of law providing that the
9 profit from the sale of certain alcoholic beverages under the license may accrue to
10 the use of the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission or the
11 concessionaire; altering the names of certain stadium licenses in the county; and
12 generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince George’s County.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
5 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

7 26–102.

8 This title applies only in Prince George’s County.

9 26–1014.

10 (a) There is a Class B–Stadium (baseball stadium) beer [and light], wine, AND
11 LIQUOR license.

12 (b) The Board may issue the license to:

13 (1) the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission; or

14 (2) a private concessionaire that is under contract with the Commission.

15 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer [and light], wine, AND
16 LIQUOR at retail to consumers for on–premises consumption in a baseball stadium owned
17 or operated by the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

18 (d) Profit from the sale of beer [or light], wine, OR LIQUOR made by a license
19 holder may accrue to the use of the Commission or the concessionaire.

20 (e) The annual license fee is \$2,420.

22 (a) There is a Class [B] B–STADIUM (FOOTBALL STADIUM) beer, wine, and
23 liquor [stadium] license.

2 (c) (1) This subsection does not apply to a Class B-Stadium (**BASEBALL**
3 **STADIUM**) beer [and light], wine, **AND LIQUOR** license, a 7-day Class B-ECR on-sale
4 beer, wine, and liquor license, or a Class B-WPL (waterfront pavilion) beer, wine, and
5 liquor license.

6 (2) To be eligible to receive a license, a partner shall:

7 (i) be a resident of the State at the time the application is filed and
8 continue to be a resident as long as the license is in effect; and

9 (ii) be a registered voter of the State.

11 (c) (1) This subsection does not apply to a Class B-Stadium (**BASEBALL**
12 **STADIUM**) beer [and light], wine, **AND LIQUOR** license, a 7-day Class B-ECR on-sale
13 beer, wine, and liquor license, or a Class B-WPL (waterfront pavilion) beer, wine, and
14 liquor license.

15 (2) To be eligible to receive a license, an applicant shall:

16 (i) be a resident of the State at the time the application is filed and
17 continue to be a resident as long as the license is in effect; and

18 (ii) be a registered voter of the State.

20 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this title, the number of licenses in a
21 class issued by the Board may not exceed:
