1 (c) (1) Unless the driver of the motor vehicle received a citation from a police 2 officer at the time of the violation, the owner or, in accordance with subsection (f)(4) of this 3 section, the driver of a motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty if the motor vehicle is 4 recorded by a speed monitoring system while being operated in violation of this subtitle.

5 (2) (I) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
6 PARAGRAPH, A civil penalty under this subsection may not exceed \$40.

7 (II) 1. THIS SUBPARAGRAPH APPLIES TO A CIVIL PENALTY 8 ASSESSED TO THE OWNER OR DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS RECORDED BY 9 A SPEED MONITORING SYSTEM WHILE BEING OPERATED ON MARYLAND ROUTE 210 10 (INDIAN HEAD HIGHWAY) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY IN VIOLATION OF THIS 11 SUBTITLE.

12 **2.** SUBJECT TO SUBSUBPARAGRAPH **3** OF THIS 13 SUBPARAGRAPH, A CIVIL PENALTY UNDER THIS SUBPARAGRAPH IS AS FOLLOWS:

14A.FOR EXCEEDING THE MAXIMUM POSTED SPEED LIMIT15BY 12 TO 21 MILES PER HOUR, \$40;

16 B. FOR EXCEEDING THE MAXIMUM POSTED SPEED LIMIT 17 BY 22 TO 31 MILES PER HOUR, \$90;

- 18 C. FOR EXCEEDING THE MAXIMUM POSTED SPEED LIMIT 19 BY 32 TO 41 MILES PER HOUR, \$160;
- 20D.For exceeding the maximum posted speed limit21by 42 to 51 miles per hour, \$290; or
- 22E.FOR EXCEEDING THE MAXIMUM POSTED SPEED LIMIT23BY 52 MILES PER HOUR OR MORE, \$530.
- 243.THE OWNER OR DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE25RECORDED BY A SPEED MONITORING SYSTEM IN VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE IS26SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL CIVIL PENALTIES:
