4 FOR the purpose of requiring a retail service station dealer in Prince George’s County to  
5 provide fuel service to certain individuals between certain hours; and generally  
6 relating to retail service station dealers.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article – Business Regulation  
9 Section 10–320  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2015 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Business Regulation**

1           (a)   **(1)**   Except as provided in [subsection (b) or (c) of this section]  
2 **PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION**, a retail service station dealer who  
3 reduces the price of motor fuel for self-service shall provide, on request, fueling service at  
4 the self-service price to a disabled driver who displays a disabled person's registration plate  
5 or parking permit issued by the Motor Vehicle Administration.

6           **[(b)] (2)**   This [section] **SUBSECTION** does not apply to a retail service station  
7 dealer who sells motor fuel from:

8                   **[(1)] (I)**   a convenience store that:

9                           **[(i)] 1.**   sells motor fuel through remotely controlled dispensing  
10 equipment; and

11                           **[(ii)] 2.**   does not provide fueling service; or

12                   **[(2)] (II)** a station that:

13                           **[(i)] 1.**   is exclusively self-service;

14                           **[(ii)] 2.**   is operated by 1 cashier; and

15                           **[(iii)] 3.**   has remotely controlled dispensing equipment.

16           **[(c)] (3)**   This [section] **SUBSECTION** does not apply to a disabled driver who:

17                   **[(1)] (I)**   is reasonably capable of providing self-service; or

18                   **[(2)] (II)** drives a motor vehicle that carries another individual who is  
19 reasonably capable of providing self-service.

20           **(B) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.**

21                   **(2) A RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER SHALL PROVIDE, ON**  
22 **REQUEST, FUELING SERVICE TO AN INDIVIDUAL BETWEEN 6:00 A.M. AND MIDNIGHT.**

23           **[(d)] (C)**   A retail service station dealer who violates this section is guilty of a  
24 misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding \$25.

1           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
2   October 1, 2024.
