2 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a person who 3 violates a watershed regulation adopted under § 17–403 of this article has committed a 4 Commission infraction.

- 5 (2) A Commission infraction does not include a violation of a watershed 6 regulation declared by law to be a criminal offense.
- 7 (3) The Commission may:

8 (i) establish a schedule of preset fines for each conviction of a 9 Commission infraction under this section;

10 (ii) impose a preset fine not to exceed [\$150] **\$500** for each 11 conviction of a Commission infraction under this section; and

12 (iii) impose a preset fine not to exceed [\$300] **\$750** for a repeat 13 offense.

14 (4) The recipient of a citation for a Commission infraction shall pay the fine 15 to the Commission within 20 calendar days after the receipt of the citation.

16 (e) A person found by the District Court to have committed a Commission 17 infraction shall pay a fine not to exceed:

- 18 (1) **[**\$150**] \$500** for a first offense; or
- 19 (2) **[**\$300**] \$750** for a repeat offense.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2025.
