 $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of establishing the Substance Abuse Early Intervention and 6 Detoxification Services Fund to provide treatment and rehabilitation to students 7 expelled from school in Prince George's County and cover expenses incurred by 8 uninsured or underinsured minors in Prince George's County for treatment services 9 related to the misuse of alcohol and drugs; requiring the Prince George's County 10 Health Department to administer the Fund; authorizing the Maryland Department 11 of Health and the Department of Juvenile Services to refer students who have been 12expelled from school to a local behavioral health authority in Prince George's County 13 for treatment and rehabilitation related to the misuse of alcohol and drugs; and 14generally relating to the Substance Abuse Early Intervention and Detoxification 15Services Fund.

1 (I) PROVIDE UP TO 90 DAYS OF TREATMENT AND 2 REHABILITATION BY THE LOCAL BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AUTHORITY FOR THE MISUSE 3 OF ALCOHOL AND DRUGS TO STUDENTS EXPELLED FROM SCHOOL IN PRINCE 4 GEORGE'S COUNTY; AND

5 (II) WITH ANY REMAINING MONEY IN THE FUND, COVER 6 EXPENSES INCURRED BY UNINSURED OR UNDERINSURED MINORS IN PRINCE 7 GEORGE'S COUNTY FOR TREATMENT AND SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE LOCAL 8 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AUTHORITY FOR THE MISUSE OF ALCOHOL AND DRUGS.

9 (3) THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL 10 ADMINISTER THE FUND.

14(II) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND15SEPARATELY, AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

(6) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR THE PURPOSES DESCRIBED IN

- 1 (7) (I) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE 2 FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
- 3 (II) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE 4 CREDITED TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.
- 5 (8) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN 6 ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
- 7 (9) ANY UNSPENT STATE APPROPRIATION TO THE FUND SHALL 8 REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE AT THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR.

9 (10) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2027, THE 10 PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE 11 GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT 12 ARTICLE, AN ANNUAL REPORT OF THE FUND THAT INCLUDES, FOR THE 13 IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR:

1 (C) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 2 GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF 3 \$2,000,000 TO THE FUND.

4 (D) THE DEPARTMENT OR THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE SERVICES MAY 5 REFER STUDENTS WHO HAVE BEEN EXPELLED FROM SCHOOL IN PRINCE GEORGE'S 6 COUNTY TO THE LOCAL BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AUTHORITY FOR TREATMENT AND 7 REHABILITATION RELATED TO THE MISUSE OF ALCOHOL AND DRUGS.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2025.
