2 **Prince George’s County – Alcoholic Beverages – Multiple Licenses Prohibition –**  
3 **Exceptions**

5 FOR the purpose of adding Class B (on–sale) beer and wine and Class B (on–sale) beer,  
6 wine, and liquor licenses to the list of alcoholic beverages licenses for which the  
7 prohibition against issuing multiple licenses for the same person or premises in  
8 Prince George’s County does not apply; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages  
9 licenses in Prince George’s County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

4 26–102.

5 This title applies only in Prince George’s County.

6 26–1505.

7 (a) Unless otherwise authorized by this article, a person may not have an interest  
8 in more than one license issued by the Board, regardless of whether the person acts on the  
9 person’s own behalf or on behalf of another person.

10 (b) The prohibition against issuing multiple licenses for the same premises or to  
11 an individual for the use of that individual, a partnership, a corporation, an unincorporated  
12 association, or a limited liability company does not apply if:

13 (1) each premises is a bowling establishment that has at least 30 lanes with  
14 automatic pinsetters; and

15 (2) the licenses were issued before June 1, 1982.

16 (c) The prohibition against issuing multiple licenses for the same person or  
17 premises does not apply to a Class B–ECF/DS license, **CLASS B (ON–SALE) BEER AND**  
18 **WINE LICENSE, OR CLASS B (ON–SALE) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.**

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
20 1, 2026.
