5 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning  
6 Commission and the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to accept as a  
7 registered vendor any person that is registered as a vendor with Montgomery County  
8 or Prince George’s County; authorizing the Maryland–National Capital Park and  
9 Planning Commission and the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to enter  
10 into certain memoranda of understanding with Montgomery County and Prince  
11 George’s County; and generally relating to procurement by the Maryland–National  
12 Capital Park and Planning Commission and the Washington Suburban Sanitary
